**Pipers and Drummers** help bring the Halifax Citadel to life, playing the music and following the daily routines of the "Pipes & Drums" of a mid-Victorian British army regiment.

**Visitor Services Operatives** make sure visitors get the most out of their visit. They process admission sales, provide orientation and guidance to visitors, and conduct tours in both English and French.
